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"Remove not the ancient landmark, which thy fathers hath set"

Landmark:

(1) an object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognised from a distance, especially one that enables someone to establish their location and know where they are.

(2) an object (as a stone or tree) that marks a boundary of land.

Landmarks and boundaries are important. Landmarks brings a sense of order, and to remove them causes chaos and confusion. When the children of Israel were to inherit their possession, God gave a specific piece of land to each tribe. Within these tribes, each family had their own possession with their own boundaries. God then further gave them this stern warning, which was not just for their time but for time to come: *"Thou shalt not remove thy neighbour's landmark, which they of old time have set in thine inheritance, which thou shalt inherit in the land that the LORD thy God giveth thee to possess it." (Deuteronomy 19:14)* Landmarks could not be removed without incurring the severe displeasure of God: "Cursed be he that removeth his neighbour's landmark. And all the people shall say, Amen." (Deuteronomy 27:17)

God has also established spiritual landmarks: "For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven." (Psalm 119: 89)

The word "settled" means "to bring to rest; to establish or secure permanently." In our ever-changing world, nothing is established or secured permanently. But God's Word is forever settled or established and secured permanently in Heaven. God's Word is settled forever and God will not be changing it. God's Word is settled forever and man cannot change it.

To add to God's words or to take away from it is to move the established landmark. The Scriptures are one type of landmark which should never be allowed to be moved, yet it is one area where Satan has been working overtime to achieve victory over God's children. From Eve in the garden of Eden, to Jesus' temptation in the wilderness, to this present day, Satan has sought to misquote God's Word. It is by the Word of God that we are established in our faith and grounded in our doctrine. Is it any wonder that Satan wishes to attack this important landmark?

Satan has done this by attacking the Scriptures through man's intellect. He has given us so called improved versions of the Word of God, when we have only needed to improve our knowledge of the one we have already. These new versions distort the meaning of God's words and some of them miss out complete verses. Consider these important verses in the King James Version which are missing from the New International Version:

(1) St. Matthew 17:21: "Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting."

(2) St. Matthew 18:11: "For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost."

(3) St. Mark 11:26: **"But** *if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses."*

(4) St. Luke 17:36: "Two men shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left."

And this is just a sample, there are many more. Since the early 17th century, we have had the Word of God in our own language. Revival has broken out in such a way as to help fulfil the command of Christ, in going forth into the whole world to preach the Gospel.

The King James Version of God's Holy Word has been the greatest tool for revival since Pentecost. Men like D. L. Moody preached to his congregation from the King James Version, with the revival fires that followed.

C. H. Spurgeon preached to those great London crowds from the King James Version, and an entire continent was affected by this preacher. Charles Finney, the great Evangelist preached from the King James Version of the Bible. In fact, every great revival has started and ended with the King James Version of Scripture. It has a heritage like no other book. It has a place like no other writings.

No wonder Satan hates the King James Version of the Bible with a passion. From the beginning of time, Satan, through his influence has used men to move the landmarks that God has established. This has been done very subtly. If someone moved a boundary by 10 metres (32 feet), it would be very easy to spot. But if it was moved by an inch at a time - e.g. one inch every year, over many years, not many people would notice. One inch every year would take 384 years to reach 32 feet but it would be so subtle that chances are no one would notice it. That's just what Satan has been doing over the many years. He has been moving the landmarks little by little. He is very patient; just one inch at a time.

Another landmark that God set in place from the creation relates to the definition of the family: *"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them."* (Genesis 1:27)

Jesus reiterated this whilst He was here on earth: *"But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female."* (St. Mark 10:6)

God did not leave His people in any doubts. He made it known what was acceptable and unacceptable behaviour: "If a man also lie with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them." (Leviticus 20:13)

As a child, Brother Joshua was asked in Sunday School what he understood by the word "abomination" and his response which I'll never forget was, "plumb disgusting." To show what God thinks of this behaviour, we only have to read about what God did to the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah, where this sin of sodomy or homosexuality was prevalent. After God sent angels to bring out Lot and his family, the men of Sodom wanted to sexually molest these men - who unknown to them were angels: ⁴"But before they lay down, the men of the city, even the men of Sodom, compassed the house round, <u>both old and</u> <u>young</u>, all the people from every quarter: ⁵And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where are the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may <u>know</u> them." (Genesis 19:4-5)

Even after Lot promised to send out his daughters, these men were not interested in the women - contrary to the natural law of nature: ²⁴"Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven; ²⁵And he overthrew those cities, and all the plain, and all the inhabitants of the cities, and that which grew upon the ground." (Genesis 19:24-25)

Today, we live in a time that has surpassed Sodom in this abomination. Jesus, speaking of the last days said it would be like the days of Sodom. These are the last days before the return of our Lord, and following His return will be the reign of the antichrist. The scene is being set for him, so we shouldn't be surprised by this current aggressive LGBT agenda that is been pushed on us. The Scriptures intimate that the antichrist will himself be a homosexual: "Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all." (Daniel 11:37)

Paul had written to the Church in Rome about these end times: ²⁴"Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves: ²⁵Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. ²⁶For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: ²⁷And likewise also the men,

leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet. ²⁸And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; ²⁹Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, malignity; murder. debate. deceit. whisperers, ³⁰Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, ³¹Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: ³²Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them." (Romans 1:24-32)

Because this landmark has been moved, the secular and religious worlds are in confusion. Some men and women no longer know who they are. The ultimate insult to God (who said it was good when He created men and women) is men and women claiming today that they are in the wrong body. God had previously set the landmark in place and made a clear distinction between the sexes when He said: "The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the LORD thy God." (Deuteronomy 22:5)

Now that the landmarks/boundaries have been removed, we have men dressing and identifying as women and women dressing and identifying as men. It's been taught by our academic institutions that there are not just two genders but hundreds, confusing our children and youth. I have even heard of four-year-olds being reprimanded by their teacher for mis-gendering another child. Children are being encouraged to identify as transgender, given puberty blockers and hormone treatment, with some even going under the knife to physically alter their identity. These are the results of moving the established landmarks and boundaries.

In the beginning, God set the landmark and defined the form of worship that was acceptable to Him. God chose the Levites and sanctified them to offer sacrifices to Him on behalf of all the people. God gave specific instructions to Moses, who in turn instructed Aaron the High Priest: *"So Aaron and his sons did all things which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses."* (Leviticus 8:36)

When Israel was obedient to God's commands, God would manifest His presence among them, to show His favour. ^{23"}And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and blessed the people: and the glory of the LORD appeared unto all the people. ²⁴And there came a fire out from before the LORD, and consumed upon the altar the burnt offering and the fat: which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces." (Leviticus 9:23-24)

God was pleased with their obedience. God still delights in obedience and frowns on disobedience: 1"And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not. ²And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD. ³Then Moses said unto Aaron, This is it that the LORD spake, saying, I will be sanctified in them that come nigh me, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his peace. ⁴And Moses called Mishael and Elzaphan, the sons of Uzziel the uncle of Aaron, and said unto them, Come near, carry your brethren from before the sanctuary out of the camp. 5So they went near, and carried them in their coats out of the camp; as Moses had said." (Leviticus 10:1-5)

God told Aaron not to mourn for his sons or leave the tabernacle to attend their funerals. These two young men thought they knew better than God and the establishment around them. They would have observed their father on many occasions and have participated in these ordinances even themselves. Perhaps they grew tired of the same old routine and wanted to spice things up a little. Maybe they wanted to introduce something new and more exciting, thinking they were doing good. These young men are like some Christians today - who get tired of the same routine and want to bring in all kinds of changes, to bring our worship more in line with the times in which we live. But if I were you I would not tamper with what God has ordained and put in place or move any of His ancient landmarks!

When the nation of Israel was beginning to stray away from Him, God's encouragement to them was: "Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein." (Jeremiah 6:16)

Sometimes landmarks get overgrown and are hard to see, but if we have lost our direction, the advice is to stand still and ask for directions. We should not let Israel's response be our response. Those who refused to walk in the old paths went into captivity in Babylon (confusion) and the majority died there.

The doctrine that God has given us, including the 29 prominent teachings and Advice to Members are all landmarks: *"Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee."* (1 Timothy 4:16)

Church members and friends, let us not remove the ancient landmarks which our fathers have set.

The new general Assembly Band Movement theme for the assembly year 2023-2024 is: **'Perfectly joined together'**



(1 Corinthians 1:10)

As a young child at school, it was so much fun working with PVA glue - especially if glitter was involved. It was messy work, but that just added to the experience. I quite liked picking the white, sticky residue from my hands after we'd finished our creations.

As an older child, Pritt Stick, or any no-name-brand derivatives were a game changer. Glue contained in one neat stick with a lid? Come on! Get in my pencil case \bigcirc I was also a lover of Blu-Tack which was perfect for my posters as a teenager - that

is, before I got into using nails to hold up picture frames.

Looking back into my late-teens, I have a distinct memory of getting superglue on my finger - it really was a *super glue*. I could hardly get the thing off my skin! But for serious jobs and things that needed bonding, this glue could not be beaten. Fast forwarding to now - there are all sorts of bonding agents on the market; we have a few at home - from spray glue to "No More Nails" adhesives. I wouldn't dare give either of those to my young children for their craft projects - nor would PVA glue have much use in Brother Stu's tool-box. The bonding agent we choose is dependent on the job.

What has all this got to do with the theme for our ABM? 1 Peter 2:5 describes us as "lively stones" building up a spiritual house. Stones piled upon one another without a bonding agent are vulnerable to collapse. This is what makes the game 'Jenga' so intense! Without the bond between the individual components, the building is compromised. When building a literal house, Pritt Stick is not on the shopping list - now we need the good stuff; cement, mortar, masonry adhesive...

What is the good stuff that is needed to bond us together as brethren? Colossians 3:14 answers this: "And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness." True love...true, love, is what will connect us harmoniously. It is an invisible bond that will positively impact not only our work and effectiveness as a Church, but our wellbeing and mental health. If we had mutual agape love 'nailed', what would that look like? ABM leaders, perhaps we could explore this within our services.

In the world in which we live, where social interaction is eroding by the day - achieving the proper connection of our members with the bond of perfectness is going to take more than just putting on additional events, or creating more opportunities for fellowship (though that is still good!) There will need to be a general consensus, full commitment and willingness to build these bonds. Not just between one and two, or this group and that group, but a heart-felt desire to see a solid, unified, close-knit Church. PVA glue just won't cut it. This desire can only come from the Lord, and will be helped by obedience to the commands within the Word of God. For example - "With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love" (Ephesians 4:2), "Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye." (Colossians 3:13), "Let love be without dissimulation... [concealment of one's thoughts, feelings, or character; pretence]". (Romans 12:9a), "... doing nothing by partiality" (1 Timothy 5:1b). What other commands are there in the Word of God that will guide us here? See if you can find them and ask the Lord for help to obey them.

As one Body, our work is stifled if we are not fitly joined together. Let the world drift away into the caves of stale love that has waxed cold. May the Body of Christ let the fire of love burn within, and bond us perfectly: "And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these." (St. Mark 12:30-31)

Sin

¹² "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" (Romans 5:12)

(Supporting Scriptures - Genesis 3:6, 1 Corinthians 15:21, Genesis 2:17).

"...by one man sin entered into the world...". The fall of one man is found in Genesis 3:1-24. When Adam sinned, his seed became corrupt. Therefore, we are sinners because we are born in sin: ⁵ "Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me." (Psalm 51:5)

Mankind does not have to teach their children to be bad or to sin. This comes naturally. We have to teach them to be good. We do not have to teach children to lie, but have to teach them to tell the truth. This supports the Scriptures that we are all born in sin.

¹⁸ "Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; ..." (Romans 5:18). According to the Word of God, all men are judged sinners; all are condemned already.

²³ "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;" (Romans 3:23). Sin entered the world through our first parents in the garden of Eden, and this made all sinners.

When Jesus Christ (the 2nd Adam) came to earth, He gave us a choice. Through His death at Calvary, mankind could be free from the sin we were born with or remain in it. Therefore, man sins by choice. The dominion sin has over us is according to how we delight in it; or the refusal to allow God's love to take us out of this condemnation.

We must teach those we come into contact with these things and let them know: ¹⁶ "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting *life.*" (St. John 3:16)

THE CHURCH OF GOD, (ENGLAND) NATIONAL MINISTERS' CONVENTION 2023

Theme: 'For the mystery of iniquity doth already work' (2 Thessalonians 2:7)

Members and friends of The Church of God (England) met at Long Lane Church, Halesowen on 4th November 2023 for the annual Ministers' Convention. The National auxiliary co-ordinators boosted the general auxiliary themes and outlined their plans for this Convention year - 23-24.

National Overseer's Address - 'For the mystery of iniquity doth already work' (2 Thessalonians 2:7)

Bishop Bennett delivered the theme message, explaining that a mystery is something difficult to understand or impossible to explain. "Iniquity" is immorality and lawlessness of mankind. The Church in Thessalonica was being deceived by false preachers, who proclaimed the rapture had already occurred. The Apostle Paul wrote letters to reassure the Church of the teaching they had already received about the rapture. From 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4 he mentioned that "the day of the Lord" is not a one-day event. It covers a time following the rapture until the great white throne judgment. This time will include the millennial reign of Christ. It will be a terrible time, when God will pour out His wrath upon a sinful world. Paul said that there would first be a falling away of saints before Christ would appear. "Falling away" means a departure from the faith. Many have fallen away from Christ since AD 325.

The encouragement was for the brethren not to be shaken or moved by anything. The sin of lawlessness already abounds - St. Matthew 24:12. God, through Moses asked the people to choose between life or death, blessing or curse. We may ask - why would man choose lawlessness and reject righteousness? 2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 shows us God will send a strong delusion so that they should believe a lie. For 'the wicked shall do wickedly but the wise shall understand'. God told Daniel to seal the words '...till the time of the end.' Daniel 12:8-10

Message by Sister Karen Richards - 'And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold' (St. Matthew 24:12)

Sister Karen expounded upon various accounts from the Bible to express how iniquity was abounding. She looked at Adam and Eve in Genesis 3:1, Noah and the Flood - Genesis 6, Lot in the city of Sodom - Genesis 19:4-12 and finally the Levite and his Concubine - Judges 19-20. In each of these accounts, exceeding wickedness ruled in men's hearts. 'Every imagination of the thoughts of man's heart was evil continually' and 'every man did that which was right in his own eyes'. These accounts of malevolence were recorded centuries ago, but moral decline is increasing each year. Today, institutions such as the royal families, world leaders and professional bodies no longer uphold just and moral standards. We read of royals selling tell-all stories about the institution that once was private. Prime Ministers and Presidents are being investigated for crimes, whilst neglecting the people they should be representing. Scandalous and sinful lifestyles are being exposed more frequently. Statistics indicate that Christianity is on the decline. The Scripture states '...the love of many shall wax cold' in St. Matthew 24:12, but not every man's heart will become cold. Just like Noah who found grace in God's eyes, we too can find grace and stay close to God, in these times.

(Satan)






(Jesus)
