"For the Mystery of Iniquity doth already work"

Mystery: something that is kept secret and is difficult or impossible to understand or explain. Iniquity: immoral or grossly unfair behaviour. A violation of the right or duty that mankind is under obligation to do. An iniquity can also be a wicked act and immoral conduct or practice. These are harmful or offensive to society and, especially to God. In the Bible, the terms, sin, and iniquity, are often used interchangeably.

Iniquity simply means lawlessness.

The majority of people today, including Christians do not understand what is going on around them. That is a part of the mystery that we are talking about.

The theme of this Convention is from Paul's second letter to the Thessalonians. The Church in Thessalonica was unsettled, due to their fear that the Day of the Lord had already taken place and they had missed the Rapture. This falsehood was being spread by false teachers, so Paul was writing to them to settle their faith:

1"Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him, ²That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. ³Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; ⁴Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God."

(2 Thessalonians 2:1-4)

Now the Day of Christ or the Day of the Lord as it is sometimes referred to, is not a one-day event as many believe. It covers a period of time from the Rapture, to the great white throne judgement. The Day of the Lord will be a terrible time when God's wrath will be poured out upon a God-hating, Christ-rejecting sinful world. It will include the time of the millennium reign of Christ.

In his bid to settle these believers, Paul explained that there was first to be a falling away of believers. There was one great falling away in AD 325 with the adoption of the Nicene Creed, but there have been many others since that time. So, this falling away is merely a departure from the true gospel preached by Christ and the early Church and not a single event. Paul went on to remind them of what they had previously been told: 5"Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? ⁶And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time." (2 Thessalonians 2:5-6) The 'what' here has reference to the restraining work of the Holy Ghost and the 'he' refers to the man of sin. Paul had already warned them about deception: 8"But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. ⁹As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed." (Galatians 1:8-9)

The revelation of the man of sin we believe will occur after the Rapture and some three and a half years into the tribulation period when he will break his peace covenant with the nation of Israel. Paul went on to say: 7"For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. 8And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: ⁹Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs lying wonders, ¹⁰And with and deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved." (2 Thessalonians 2:7-10)

Right now, the Holy Ghost is the restraining force against the forces of evil. Once He is taken out of the way, the anti-Christ will be revealed and will be able to work without restraint.

<u>Paul-Henri Spaak</u>, a former Belgian Prime Minister and one of the principal architects of what has <u>since</u> become known as the European Union (who also served as the first Secretary of the United Nations) spoke these chilling **prophetic words** back in the 1970's: "We do not want another committee, we have too many already. What we want is a man of sufficient stature to hold the allegiance of all people, and to lift us out of the economic morass into which we are sinking. Send us such a man, and be he god or devil, we will receive him."

These words remind me of Caiaphas' prophecy concerning Christ's death, where he prophesied that it was needful for one man to die (Christ) rather than for the whole nation to perish. Right now, the scene is being set for the coming man of sin. Jesus has already told us what the times would be like in the last days before His coming: "And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold." (St. Matthew 24:12)

We may ask the question, why would mankind choose **iniquity**, which is lawlessness with the death and destruction that accompanies it, and refuse righteousness and the blessings that goes with it? **This is the mystery**, but the answer can be found in verses 11 and 12: ¹¹"And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: ¹²That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness."

(2 Thessalonians 2:11-12)

Because of their rejection of the truth, "God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient" (Romans 1:28) Although men know the consequences for their behaviour, the momentary pleasure that they get from these disobedient and variant lifestyles means more to them than denying themselves and spending eternity in heaven. God speaking through the prophet Moses admonished the people: "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:" (Deuteronomy 30:19)

Yet people are practicing lifestyles that are actually killing them and shortening their lives. They are literally choosing death over life. The world is in confusion where men call good, evil and evil, good. Many find it difficult to differentiate their friends from their enemies and so shun those who mean them well and embrace the enemy of their souls.

This can be seen in the political world for example, where antisemitism, a hatred of the Jews and Israel is at an all-time high. Because of biased reporting, Israel - the only true democracy in the Middle East is seen as an evil, apartheid country. The devil and his cronies use the media to malign those who are good, until we start to see them as bad and vice versa.

Satan elicits sympathy for the LGBT community by convincing people that it cannot be wrong if two people simply love each other, and that they were born that way so they cannot help themselves. I see LGBT activists marching in support of Hamas, an organization that would kill them if they ever set foot in Gaza. This is a mystery. Why would one support an organization that given the opportunity, would kill them?

Satan uses euthanasia or assisted dying as an argument that it is only reasonable for someone in constant pain with an incurable illness to be able to end their life in a dignified way. The countries that allow this practice have seen the number of such deaths multiply over the years. All kinds of reasons are subsequently used to terminate a life, including children from the age of 12 in some countries.

Abortion is seen as a woman's right to choose instead of the murder of the unborn-which it is. Millions of unborn babies are murdered every year with government approval. Any opposition is viewed as a restriction on a woman's right to choose. Satan tries to play on our sympathies and the world paints us as un-Christian, cruel and hateful if we dare to oppose his agenda,

which is sending thousands of people to hell every day.

What do all of the above have in common? Answer, a hatred of God and everything that God has set in order. So the LGBT agenda, the abortion agenda, Black Lives Matter, Radical Islam etc. are all cut from the same cloth. If we notice, when one party protests, all the others are represented with their flags and their slogans. Verse 4 of 2 Thessalonians Chapter 2, in speaking of the anti-Christ said he "opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God..."

Satan, who will give his powers to this man of sin is a master strategist who has been around for a long time. We are no match for him by ourselves. His original name, Lucifer means "Light bringer." He was perfect in beauty and referred to as the "Star of the Morning." He was so beautiful and influential that we are told in Revelation 12:4 that "...his tail drew a third part of the stars of God..." He was able to convince a third of the angels in heaven to follow him, and is convincing the majority of the world today to follow him.

Although there is a great mystery in iniquity, we as God's children should not be ignorant of the devil's devices. After revealing the end times to Daniel, God gave him some closing words: ⁸"And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, what shall be the end of these things? ⁹And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end. ¹⁰Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand." (Daniel 12:8-10)

Let us not be perplexed by what is happening around us as the unwise. As God's children, we must be wise and have an understanding of the times we are living in.

(St. Luke 22:42)

Our will is that part of the mind by which we determine either to do, or not to do an action. Our will, is the part of us which we exercise in deciding, among two or more objects, which

What's happening at Long Lane Church?


Mothering Sunday – 10th March 2024
